#### Review of 2014:

- Over 100 presentations/training sessions occurred during this past year
- In April train-the-trainer took place in Wpg. 30 volunteer trainers in program now.
- 55 groups are active in Manitoba this equals to over 1200 members. There were 18,000 hours patrolled and 27,500 hours volunteered.

#### New groups formed:

- Charleswood
- Niverville (Re-activated)

#### **Future plans:**

- Encourage groups to contact Tracey Proctor when having events and activities in their communities.
- Have Road Safety activities in your communities involving MPI (I.E. Distracted driving simulator) to get individuals interested.
- Having a coordinator in service Spring of 2015.

#### **Cell Phones:**

- MTS will not be providing network service for flip phones any longer, causing the program to change over to IPhone or Blackberries.
- Tracey Proctor will contact the groups that still currently use flip phones and discuss options.
- The PAC committee and MPI will review current phone policy and notify of any changes groups may face.

#### **Criminal Record Checks:**

- CR Checks are to be done every 2 years by ALL members of the COPP group.
- Plan as a group to get these done to make it easier for everyone.
- Having everyone do their CR Checks is the best way to keep updated records.
- By June 2015 all groups must have checks completed.
- RCMP detachment and website has a list of all detachments that have the electronic fingerprinting.
